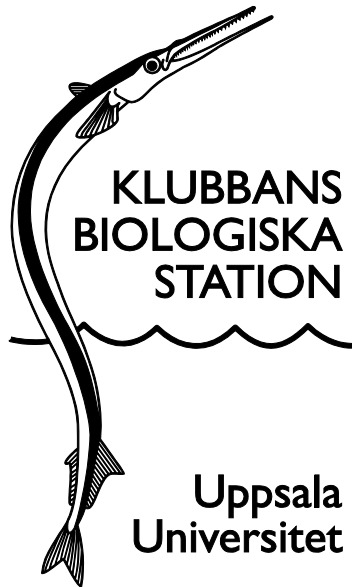


Course information



Welcome to Klubbans Biological Station! We hope you will enjoy your stay with us and get a lot out of your stay. Klubbans Biological Station is located at Gullmarsfjorden on the East Side in Fiskebäckskil. On the other side of the fjord is Lysekil. The station came about through a donation in 1915. It is managed and owned by Uppsala University and used for teaching and research.

The **station building** contains an auditorium, which holds about 35 people and is equipped with TV, VCR, video camera connected to a stereoscopic microscope, OHP and slide projector, stereo and ordinary microscopes. The computers are connected to the Internet and to laser printers. A computer room is next to the classroom, and a smaller one with two computers is located on the second floor.

The station has surface and deep-water facility and several aquarium rooms that make it easy to store marine organisms and perform experiments. The station building has 10 beds for researchers and teachers. On the ground floor (at the office) is a coffee / lunch room to be used by everyone working here with us.

The boat Belone that takes a maximum of 34 people is equipped for marine sampling. There are also two boats with outboard engines (Sprattus and Örnvik) and a boat with inboard engine (Maja). In addition there are three rowing boats. To operate the motorboats you need permission from your course leader.

The student accommodation is located about 500 m from the station and about 100 m from the parking lot where the bus stops. The camp consists of two houses, the annex building and the barracks. The annex has two floors and consists of quadruples, as well as a twin room with bunk beds. Both houses have a laundry room, toilets, shower facilities and a kitchen. The annex also has a living room. You can find everything you need to cook your own food in the kitchen. The houses have electric heating.

You should bring towels, sheets and pillowcases (pillows, duvets and blankets are provided). Other things that are good to have: Notebook, thermos, warm clothes, boots, rainwear and house shoes. Also bring binoculars if you have any for bird watching etc.

Food is important. You will cook your own food, and should have shopped before you come to the station. It will be best if you form cooking teams. There is a supermarket, the Skaftö Hall, a few kilometres away in Fiskebäckskil. You can also find post offices in many shops.

Other rules are posted on notices at the station and you can also learn by your course leader and station staff. We have no cleaning staff; instead all of us together keep all areas clean and tidy for everyone's comfort.
