Welcome to Klubbans Biologiska Station!

We hope you will enjoy your stay with us and otherwise get a lot out of your Klubban-visit! Klubban Biological Station is located at the Gullmaren Fjord on the east side of Fiskebäckskil. On the other side of the fjord lies Lysekil. The station was founded by a donation 1915. It is managed and owned by Uppsala University and used for teaching and research.

In the main building there is an auditorium/lab, which seats about 35 people and is equipped with large screen display, video camera connected to a stereo microscope, video projector, stereo and compound microscopes. The computers are connected to the internet and a laser printer/scanner. There is a computer room next to the auditorium, and a smaller one with two computers on the 2nd floor.

The station has surface and deep water systems and several aquarium rooms that make it easy to keep marine organisms and perform experiments. The station building has 10 beds for researchers and teachers. On the ground floor (at the office) is a coffee / lunch room that can be used by all who work here with us.

The ship *Belone*, which takes a maximum of 34 persons, is equipped for marine sampling. There are also two boats with outboard engines (*Sprattus* and *Örnvik*) and a boat with an inboard (*Maja*). In addition there are three rowing boats, which may be used. To use the power boats, you need assignment from your course leader.

The lodging for students is about 500 m from the station and about 100 m from the parking lot where the bus stops. It consists of two buildings, the Annex and the Barracks. The Annex has two floors with five four-bed rooms and two two-bed rooms. Both houses have laundry and shower facilities, kitchen and living room. Here is everything you need to cook your own food! Each house has electric heating.

You should bring your own towels, sheets and pillow cases (pillows and comforters / blankets provided). Other items that are useful to bring: Notebook, thermos, warm clothes, boots, rain coat and indoor slippers. Also bring binoculars if you have a pair!

Food is important. You will cook your own food, and should have stocked up on groceries before you get to Klubban. It is best if you form cooking-teams. In Fiskebäckskil there is a small supermarket, Skaftöhallen, a few kilometers walk from the station. There you also have postal services (opening times, see the billboard at the dorm).

Further rules and regulation are posted at the station and you can also learn them from your instructors and the station's staff. We have no cleaning staff, so each one will help keeping clean and neat for everyone's comfort.
